

NHS SERVICE HOURS

An important tenet of the National Honor Society is service. Below is an explanation of the service required for continued membership in the National Honor Society. Everyone must staff the ambassador table at least one mod per cycle.

NHS AMBASSADOR TABLE

1. It is our responsibility to staff the ambassador table at least one mod per cycle.
2. If the mod allocated for you does not work please see your advisor with an alternative suggestion.
3. Please do not forget to **sign in with Mrs. Bauman** in the general office at the beginning of the mod.
4. It is essential for you to show up. Administrative staff relies on you to run errands for them. If you cannot for whatever reason you must see me and try to get a replacement. Do not assume the other person will cover for you.
5. When you are on duty you are expected to remain at the table. Reading and/or doing homework is fine.
6. Please do not socialize, eat food, or lounge on the table while on duty.
7. If you know you are to miss an assignment, please find a replacement and let Mrs. Bauman know.
8. Keep up the good work!

During the course of the school year, you must complete an additional minimum of 10 hours of service. These are separate from other service hours needed for graduation. The following is a list of different opportunities from which to choose. If there is something else you would like to do, please clear it with one of the advisors. Keep track of your hours and submit them by the end of the third quarter. Be sure to have an authorized person sign the document. Sheets are available on the web site or in my room (S420)

TUTORING

NEW STUDENT INDUCTION

6 students are needed to help with programs, greeting and escorting parents and guests. This is a dress-up event.

BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT

10 – 12 students are needed to greet and direct parents during back to school night held in September.

ST. MARTIN HOUSE

Edgewood serves dinner to those in need at St. Martin House the first Monday and last Tuesday of each month from 3:45 – 5:15 pm. It counts as 1-1/2 hours. 3 – 4 people are needed for each time.

HONORS CONVOCATION (Juniors only)

6 – 8 students are needed to help set up, hand out programs, and greet and escort guests prior to the Honors Convocation.

GRADUATION (Juniors only)

Eight students are needed to help during the graduation ceremony (4:45 – 6:15 pm). Eight students are also needed for the Graduation Liturgy. Duties include handing out programs and ushering. Both are dress-up events.

OPEN HOUSE

8 - 12 students are needed to greet and direct parents and prospective students during back to school night held twice in the fall. Hours will vary.

SERVICE PROJECT

The National Honor Society sponsors an annual fund-raising event. The project and recipient of the fund-raiser is chosen by the members. Hours will vary.
